Meadowbrook Elementary Skybound Scholars – Exploring with Drones and Discovering the World

A STEM program utilizing drones to help students solve real-life simulated challenges.

North Middle School: PBIS Team

Motivators for college and career readiness as well as encouragement for prosocial behaviors.

South Middle School: Outside the Walls Learning

Educational field trips to support students through the closure of South Middle School during construction.

South Middle School: A Quality Start

New science equipment to support the new learning labs in the new South Middle School.

Stevens High School, Black Hawk Elementary and Canyon Lake: Midwest Band Clinic

A professional development at an International Band clinic to learn new concepts regarding technique, selection, curriculum, recruitment and retention.

Stevens High School: Discovering Paleontology

Bringing in a content expert, Walter Stein, to include a lecture and hands-on activities that link to specific science standards through the study of fossils.

East Middle School: Beekeeping

Students will have first-hand experience monitoring, winterizing and upkeeping beehives that are stationed at Outdoor Campus West. In addition, they will process honey, clean frames to render beeswax, identify common pests in the hives and study the life cycles of bees and their ecological importance.
